Chapter Assessment Program Summary
(updated August 26, 2020)**

As a result of the University of Delaware suspending in-person classes and on-campus activities in March 2020, FSL staff made major adjustments to this semester's Chapter Assessment Program to reflect new operating realities. Any items no longer achievable (i.e. in-person attendance or activities) were removed while existing items were adjusted to include virtual options, as applicable, as well as suggested resources. Many items were adjusted to receive credit if the information was submitted, rather than earning credit based a scale of values. Lastly, many repercussions, limitations, or sanctions for not completing items were removed (e.g., recruitment of first semester first year students) – please note, these changes will apply to Spring 2020 only.

Delta Gamma – the Zeta Chi chapter of Delta Gamma closed on May 17, 2020 per the decision of Delta Gamma's Fraternity Council.
